SEATTLE WANTS TO SPEND \$236 MILLION ON A NEW JAIL WHILE IT CLOSES SCHOOLS AND CUTS SOCIAL SERVICES.

WE WANT THAT MONEY FOR REAL SOLUTIONS TO THE ROOT CAUSES OF SOCIAL PROBLEMS.

Campaign to get Initiative 100 on the ballot to make the city do a racial disparity study and put it to a vote before they can build the jail.

Imprisonment has quadrupled in the US since 1980, and targets people of color, poor people, women, and sexual/gender outsiders.

Queer and trans people, especially people of color, are disproportionately poor and homeless due to job discrimination, school discrimination and family rejection.

Queer and trans people are overrepresented in prisons and jails and are enormous sources of violence for our community.

Issues of gender and sexual violence are being used to justify the ongoing growth of imprisonment
